The permission cover the area from Milan in North Italy to Rome, in South. Some leading industrial companies of Turkey could import industrial machines, charging stages, wind energy facilities, boilers, steel rolls and so on from here. We will not only load a cargo from Italy, we also will make transit passes through Italy. We have already realised special project shipments from European countries like Germany and Austria through Ro-Ro ship in Italy. We will not loss time anymore from now on due to this permission. Now we are more economic and faster. We will also not to wait for permissions from the Italian authorities for every shipment that may take time 3 to 4 weeks. We would load shipments without waiting any more.
